


Student Residence Auckland

Railway Campus

The Railway Campus is located just a few minutes walk from downtown Auckland city. Formerly the Railway Station of the city, this building, with national heritage status, is a grand architectural statement in the heart of the city. As the residence is shared with local university students, Kaplan Aspect students have the opportunity to meet New Zealanders as well as students from all over the world. There are 230 furnished self-contained apartments with single and twin bedrooms available to Kaplan Aspect students. Students can opt for a meal plan at the fully licensed café and bar, or choose the self catering option and use the large communal kitchens to prepare their own meals. There is an extensive range of communal facilities available to students including: a library, gymnasium, computer lab, Sky TV lounge, outdoor barbeque area, games room, well equipped kitchens and dining areas, laundry room, music practice rooms, giant chess board area, reading and study rooms and much more.

Accommodation details

Type of accommodation

Students have the option of either single or twin accommodation.

Meals and kitchen

Meal plans are available with various combinations from NZD 70 – NZD 80 per week. Students can also choose self-catering and prepare their own meals in the available kitchens, where there are lockable cupboards and fridges. A kitchen pack is obtainable for NZD 6.50.

Rooms

Each bedroom consists of one or two beds, wardrobe space, bedside table and desk.

Bathrooms

Each bedroom has a bathroom area, with toilet, shower and basin. This is shared by up to four other students.

Utilities

Electricity, gas, heating and water costs are included in the weekly price, however telephone and food bills are not included. The electrical current in NZ is 230 volts AC 50. There is a television jack in the lounge area so students can hire or purchase their own television.

Internet and phone

An internet connection is available in every bedroom, at the student's expense. This involves a setup and weekly fee, students should provide their own connection cords. Telephones are provided in the rooms, and students are responsible for all charges before departure.

Laundry

There are communal laundry facilities with coin-operated washers and dryers. Tokens can be purchased at reception.

Security and keys

Access to the residence is restricted by an electronic security system. There is also a CCTV system operational.

Linens and towels

A bed linen package can be hired or purchased upon arrival and includes linen, duvet, blanket and pillow. Towels are not provided.

Visitors

No unaccompanied visitors are allowed into the residence and visitors must leave by 11pm.

Noise and restrictions

Students must be considerate and keep noise to a minimum, especially in the evenings. In addition, alcohol and smoking are only permitted in certain areas.

Availability

The residence is available all year, subject to availability at time of booking.
